13. Public Rights of Way Orientation Panel:

One of the aspects that the Neighbourhood Plan has been looking at is the Public Rights of Way in the Parish and how to promote their usage. An orientation panel located in the centre of the village would be a good way to show where the footpaths are to encourage their usage.

An indicative quotation has been sought for the construction and installation of a panel which is in the sum of £4,160.40. Councillor Harman has arranged to contribute £1,633.65 of her Ashford Borough Council Ward member grant towards the project. There are sufficient funds available within the s106 monies held by Ashford Borough Council to meet the shortfall.

Recommendation: To authorise the Parish Clerk to submit an application to Ashford Borough Council for the release of sufficient funds from the s106 monies to enable an order to be placed.

14. Aldington Meadows:

Report ABPC/2022/12 summarises the recreation area at Aldington Meadows is very much in the same form as it was when the land was passed from Bellway Homes to the Parish Council by way of Section 106 agreement. The area has matured in terms

of the planting but the play area is now in need of attention given its age and the limited age range that it caters for.

There is in addition the area to the back of the site which was originally a tennis court when the prison service occupied the site prior to the development taking place which would appear to have been a grass court as there is no evidence of any sub base and the strength of undergrowth that has taken over despite having been cut down to ground level on more than one occasion.
