1. SUMMARY:

Under the 2021 Environment Act, public authorities (including Parish Councils) who operate in England must consider what they can do to conserve and enhance biodiversity in England.

2. REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION.

Government guidance published on 17th May 2023 clarifies that, as a public authority, parish council must:

- Consider what they can do to conserve and enhance biodiversity,
- Agree policies and specific objectives based on their consideration,
- Act to deliver their policies and achieve their objectives.

Parish Councils, unlike other authorities, are not obliged to publish a report on their actions, but the Government guidance requires all public authorities to complete their first consideration of what action to take for biodiversity by 1st January 2024.

4. INTRODUCTION:

A template policy has been produced by the Society of Local Council Clerks for parishes to adopt which meets the initial requirements of the guidance.
